

Know What's In Your Skin Care Products

Mineral Oil or Paraffin (Derived from petroleum, oxidizer)	Propylene Glycol or Butylene Glycol (Organ system toxicant, linked to kidney damage and liver abnormalties)	Phenoxyethanol (Allergenic substance, reproductive toxicity concerns)
Polyquaternium-7, Polyethylene Glycol (PEG), or Ethylene Glycol (EG) (Skin irritants, listed as a known carcinogen by the FDA)	Disodium EDTA (Enhances skin penetration of all ingredients)	Glyceryl Stearate or Glyceryl Steareate SE (Oxidizers)
PEG-8, PEG-40, PEG-100 Stearate or other PEGs (Skin irritants, increases risk of premature aging)	Potassium Hydroxide or Sodium Hydroxide (Skin irritants, toxic to neurological and organ systems, degrades natural skin barrier)	Parabens (Methyl, Propyl, Butyl or Ethyl) (Endocrine disruption, toxic to the organ system, biochemical or cellular level changes)
